The Alumni Mentoring Program

Founded by alumna **YanJie Hou '06**, the Alumni Mentoring Program connects current students with dedicated alumni volunteers across a wide range of industries.

Through one-on-one mentorship and group programming, students gain exposure to careers, expand their interests beyond the classroom, and build the confidence and skills needed for long-term success.

In the past year alone, the program has matched over 130 students with more than 65 alumni mentors across industries including finance, medicine, law, technology, and public service. As interest continues to grow, the program is expanding to reach more students at every grade level.

For alumni, the program offers a meaningful way to give back – making a direct impact on students' lives while strengthening connections across the Stuyvesant community.

StuyPrep

StuyPrep continues its largest expansion yet, providing free SHSAT preparation and academic enrichment to middle school students from historically underserved communities across New York City.

Powered by alumni philanthropy and partnerships – including lead support from the **Arthur M. Blank Family Foundation** – the program now serves 200 students annually, with strong outcomes in specialized high school admissions.

Students in the program represent more than 50 middle schools across the city. Through over 60 hours of instruction, practice exams, and mentorship, StuyPrep equips students with the tools and confidence needed to succeed. In recent years, approximately 20% of participants have earned admission to specialized high schools.

Each student represents a step toward expanding access to opportunity – one in which talent, ambition, and preparation align. With your support, we are poised to impact hundreds more students in the years ahead.





SHSAA Scholarships

SHSAA Scholarships help college-bound seniors close that gap, providing critical support to students as they take the next step in their academic journeys. In 2025 alone, 51 scholarships totaling over \$100,000 were awarded to deserving students.

With additional support, even more students can benefit – ensuring that financial need never stands in the way of opportunity.

College Champions

The College Champions program connects current students with recent alumni (graduates of the last decade) who share candid insights into their college experiences. By offering guidance on academics, campus life, and decision-making, alumni help students make more informed choices about their futures.

Independent Research Program

Stuyvesant has a long tradition of excellence in research, with students regularly earning national recognition through competitions such as the Regeneron Science Talent Search. Through the Independent Research Program, alumni support students by providing mentorship, feedback, and, when possible, access to research environments.

In 2025, four Stuyvesant students were named Scholars in the Regeneron Science Talent Search, placing them among the top 300 high school researchers in the nation. This recognition reflects the depth of student inquiry and the strength of mentorship that supports original research at Stuyvesant.

As the program continues to grow, alumni across disciplines – STEM and beyond – play a vital role in helping students pursue original research and develop the skills that define the next generation of innovators.

Ilana D. Weinstein '88 founded The IDW Group in 2003 to address the global talent needs of the alternative investment community. Over the past two decades she has scaled the firm into a powerhouse, recognized as the thought leader on the acquisition of talent and what it takes to build and sustain world class teams.

The IDW Group was the subject of a 2023 Harvard Business School case study and Ms. Weinstein received the HBS Club of New York's Entrepreneurship Award in 2024. Ms. Weinstein has been called "One of the Most Powerful Women in Hedge Funds" by The Wall Street Journal, a "Winner in the Hedge Fund Poaching Game" by Bloomberg, "Wall Street's Hedgehunter" by CNBC and was named One of the 50 Over 50 (Investment) Women by Forbes in 2025.

She has lectured at Harvard and Wharton, is a frequent guest on Bloomberg and CNBC and featured on prominent podcasts and conference panels discussing her insights on identifying and attracting elite talent, the evolving landscape of high-stakes recruiting, market trends and the hedge fund universe.

The Outstanding Pegleg In Broadcasting Award

For over four decades, **Sam Rosen '64** has been the legendary voice of the New York Rangers on MSG Network. Before becoming one of the most recognizable broadcasters in sports – calling games for ESPN, Fox Sports, and the Stanley Cup – Rosen was a Stuyvesant student commuting to East 15th Street.

The son of Polish immigrants who prioritized education, Rosen followed his brother to Stuyvesant, where he excelled as an athlete. He captained the baseball team in 1964, balancing rigorous academics with practices near the East River and games in Central Park. It was during these years that his interest in broadcasting began, often carrying a transistor radio to listen to games.

Rosen credits Stuyvesant's competitive environment with pushing him to work harder and expanding his worldview through its location in the heart of Manhattan. Now transitioning toward retirement after a career synonymous with New York sports, he views his Stuyvesant foundation as the catalyst for the confidence and community-mindedness that defined his professional journey.

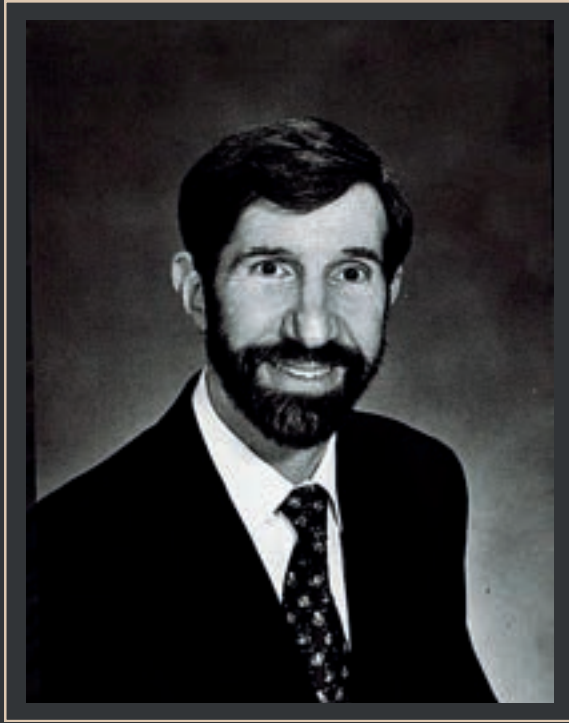

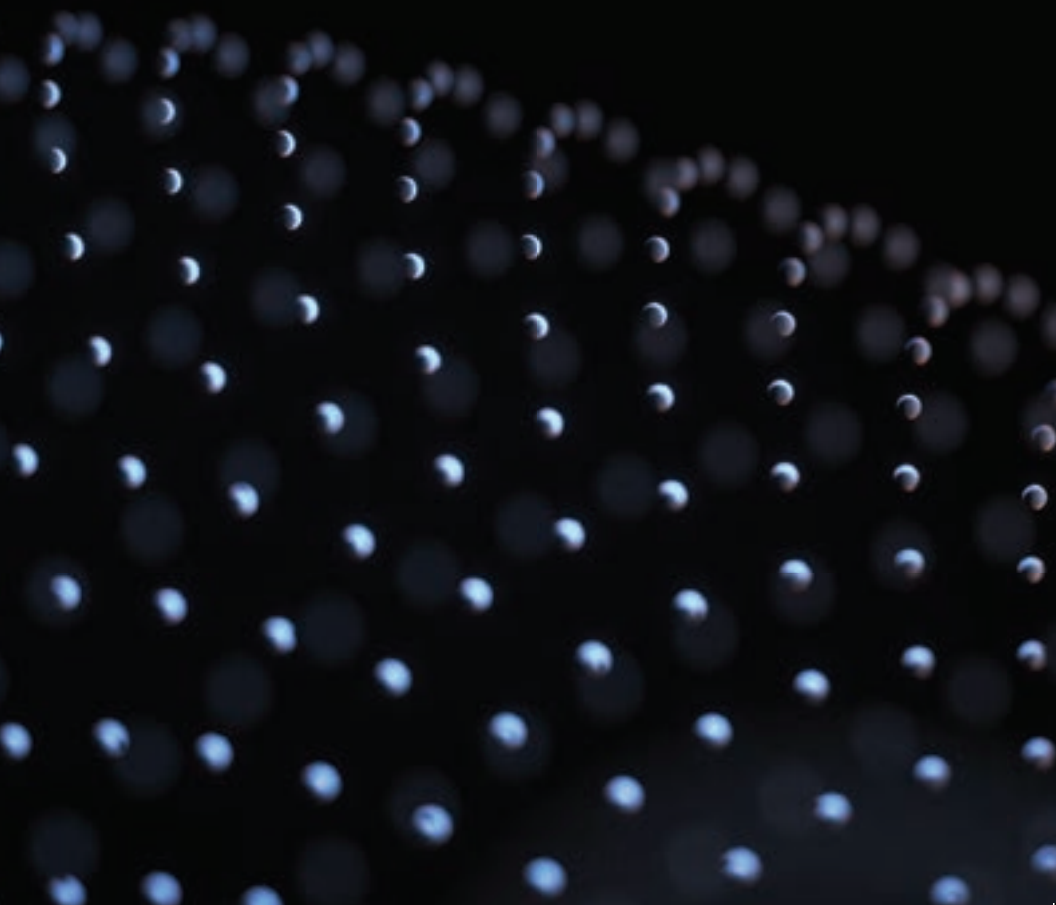

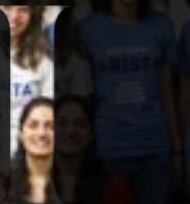
